From the Pastor...

I believe in resurrection. About 2000 years ago, the dead body of Jesus that was laid in a borrowed tomb left the grave clothes behind and stepped out into the morning dawn. Jesus appeared bodily. Jesus cooked breakfast for his disciples. Jesus stood before them as the Risen Savior. And from that moment on, everything in the world changed.

I believe in resurrection. Somehow, in the mystery and magnificence of God, we who are followers of Jesus will be raised to new life like him. Death will not have the final say in our mortal bodies. The grave will not contain us because the same power that

was at work to raise the dead body of our Lord will enliven us, the living and the dead, and we will receive, mystery of mysteries, a new body, a heavenly body, ourselves.

I believe in resurrection. Lives that are utterly ruined by bad choices, by addictions, by tragedies that cannot be imagined, such lives can be restored. Relationships that have been utterly shattered can be repaired. Hearts that have been broken by grief, loss, or hopelessness can be healed. Marriages that have been stagnated by pain, lack of trust, lack of love, they can be reignited.

I believe in resurrection. Churches that have dwindled, have lost direction, have lost hope, have lost membership, have lost impact in their communities, and have lost their ability to envision anything other than what they have experienced in the past, these churches can be reborn.

I believe in resurrection. It is not just something that happened 2000 years ago at Easter. It happens all the time. It happens because our God is the God of resurrection.

"A Year of Giving..." Pastoral Care Encouragement

I talked to a fellow Christian about how our church made 2021 the 'year of giving'. I asked him about who had taught him how to give and he shared with me how his parents had told him to never meet a stranger. His parents then explained to him what that meant, "When you see someone who needs help, do not judge. See what their need is and give as Jesus would give." His parents gave an example of what happened to them. They had been travelling and stopped at Kentucky Fried Chicken to get lunch. When they pulled in, there was a young lady sitting on the sidewalk with a sign that said, 'hungry'. Both of his parents talked to the lady and found out that she had not eaten in days. They took her inside and bought her lunch. They ordered the food and sat down with her and ate as she shared her story. Her boyfriend had beaten her and kicked her out of their apartment. She went on to share more about her situation. She also shared that she had once been a believer in Christ, but because of her situation, she had lost faith in her fellow man and in Jesus. That opened the door for them to share about Christ and His love and forgiveness. As they talked and prayed with her, she told them that she was willing to talk to a pastor and perhaps visit the local church. Because they took time to listen and buy her lunch, two great gifts were given to her: she was not judged and she was given courage to reach out to fellow Christians again. In our giving to others, we need to love unconditionally and show them the grace and love of Jesus that is for all people – no matter what is going on in their lives. As we walk through life, we all carry a history of hurt and pain from situations in our lives but let's reach beyond ourselves and give to others the gift of hope that Jesus has given to us.
