From the Pastor...

As we enter a new phase in the fight against COVID-19, first, I want to thank you all at Calvary for the way you have loved your neighbor by following the CDC guidelines for mask wearing over the last 12 months. We have been blessed that we have not had any cases of COVID-19 at Calvary due to our gatherings, and this is because of your attention to care for one another by following the advice of medical professionals. Second, I know that most of us at Calvary have been vaccinated. I realize that

medical decisions are private and personal decisions, and we want to respect those who choose, for whatever reason, not to be vaccinated. But, I would encourage you, if you have yet to be vaccinated, to talk to your own doctor and talk to your family, and make a well-thought-out decision. We want each of you to be well and to make the best decision for you and your family.

Third, I have talked with our leadership team about ways that we can express our gratitude to medical professionals who have been on the front lines during this pandemic. We owe a huge debt of gratitude to the scientists, the geneticists, the doctors, the nurses, the hospital custodial staff, the care givers in our nursing homes, all the medical professionals and their support staff who have seen us through this trying time. I am particularly thankful for those who helped develop the vaccines. I think we take for granted the impact that they have in partnering with God to bring help and healing in times like these. We should express our gratitude to them, and over the next few weeks, as a church family, we will be doing just that. I'll be sharing more information about that in the weeks ahead.

Fourth, in the weeks and months ahead, we will be able to do some things that we have not been able to do over the last year. We are meeting for Sunday Morning Bible Study beginning June 6 at 9:30. We have a church-wide cookout planned for July 4 following worship. We are working on putting together a Saturday children's VBS day-camp experience toward the end of July for our kids and for our community. We are reaching out to invite families of children at the Waldorf School to experience worship with us. We are praying about and planning for a 24-hour prayer vigil at Calvary coupled with an outdoor musical outreach on our front steps on July 16-17. We are going forward in the name of Jesus Christ by the power of His Spirit as we live out our Calvary purpose of "Following Jesus. Friending the world."

So, as we take off our masks, it is time to roll up our sleeves. There is some good work to be done. -- Rendell

COVID-19 Policy Update

Our deacons have updated our policy regarding masks and social distancing. Mask wearing is voluntary. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, please do so. The pews near the rear of the sanctuary will be marked for social distancing.
