From the Pastor...



As we celebrate our national day of independence, July 4, 1776, we are reminded as thankful Americans what that declaration of independence was all about: the birth of America, freedom of the colonies from British rule and the representationless tyranny of the powerful, autonomy of the colonies to determine self-government, and, as Jefferson penned in the first paragraph of the Declaration of Independence, "to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another."

It is July 4, 2021, and it is time for the Church in America to draft Her Declaration of Independence. It shall be a declaration in which we, the followers of Jesus Christ, our only Lord, Sovereign, and King, unequivocally declare our independence from earthly powers that hold sway in the minds and hearts of those who would be riotous crusaders in the name of Christ; from political ideologies on either the left or the right which do not align with the truth of the Scriptures and the Spirit of Christ; from populist personalities who play with people's passions and fan the flames of false narratives; from rhetoric that is devoid of truth and truth that is devoid of Christ-like love; from pundits who unabashedly twist and distort reality to fit a narrative of their own liking; from leaders inside and outside the Church who have sold themselves out to an agenda that hardly resembles the Beatitudes and that ignores the call of God toward Christlike humility and true unbiased justice.

It shall be the Church's declaration of Her independence from being pulled apart by human government, being pulled down by incessant argument, being pulled along by the force of a popular social movement. She shall declare independence from being duped into the false hope of sword-bearing and being drawn into the darkness by the carnal fear of powerlessness. It shall declare Her independence from the loudest voices and the proudest voices, from the unnecessary exclusivity of nationalism and the empty promise of socialism, from the dead end road of extremism on either the right or the left.

It shall be the Church's declaration of Her independence from mere party politics which supplants authentic Biblical discipleship.

It is July 4, 2021. It is time.

COVID-19 Policy Update

Our deacons have updated our policy regarding masks and social distancing. Mask wearing is voluntary. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, please do so. We respect your decision to wear or not wear a mask. For your own wellbeing, we encourage those who have not yet been vaccinated to wear a mask. Children's workers will wear masks while working with children, but we leave it up to parents to decide whether their children will wear masks. We will continue to provide masks at church. Also, the front pews of the church will *not* be marked off for social distancing. We encourage our church members to sit closer to the front of the sanctuary, leaving room for guests and social distancing nearer to the rear of the sanctuary. The pews near the rear of the sanctuary will be marked for social distancing.

The weekend of **July 16-17**, we will have a **24-hour** prayer vigil in our sanctuary. The prayer vigil will focus our attention on praying for our community and discerning our role in doing God's work in our neighborhood and city. On that Friday night and Saturday


VBS Day Camp

Parking at Calvary


