



From the Pastor...



Our first purpose is simply to LIVE. That might sound strange, but there is purpose just in our living. Life itself not only has purpose, it is purpose. Life is fragile, more so than we realize most days. And, so long as we have life in us, our purpose is to simply live. To live is to be present for whatever it is that is next in life, the easy and the hard. If we are alive, we have purpose, because living is itself, inherently, purpose. God said "Let there be LIFE! And there was LIFE. And LIFE was good, purposeful in and of itself."

Our second purpose is to LOVE. We can *love people* and find our purpose. Even if our families are small or non-existent, even if we have few close friends, even if we are not connected to a large community, we can love others. We can love someone we pass on the street. We can find someone to love, someone we can show love to. Love is an action. And, we can love God and find our purpose. To love God is to understand that God is Love and that He loves us. To love God is not to romanticize a relationship with God, but rather, to love the things God loves and the people God loves. To love God is to see the depth of His love for us: Jesus Christ crucified and raised from the dead. Jesus said "Love God and love your neighbor as yourself." Purpose is found when we love.

Our third purpose is to LEARN. We are never too old to learn, and I don't mean learning arithmetic or history or chemistry. Real learning is life learning, faith learning. It's learning from what we experience and acting on what we learn. Jesus was and is a teacher. We are his students. And all of life is the classroom in which Jesus sits down beside us and helps us through the problems, not "word problems" but "life problems." We learn from our mistakes and our successes. We learn what it means to be forgiven and to forgive, to be courageous in the face of fearful situations, to listen instead of talk, to be humble rather than filled with pride. We learn who we are and who God is in Christ. Jesus said, "The student is not greater than the teacher." We can all learn, and in our learning, there is purpose.

To live, to love, and to learn. In these lie our purpose. You might be inclined to think that these purposes are not "spiritual" enough. I didn't say anything about the five life purposes outlined by Rick Warren in his now classic book "The Purpose Driven Life." But, at the core of all that is purposeful in life are these three purposes: to live, to love, and to learn. They are spiritual to the core, and as we see in life and all its circumstances a chance to live, to love, and to learn, purpose is there, not under the surface, but in plain view.
