From the Pastor...



Have you joined the "Wordle" craze? I have. In case you are unfamiliar with "Wordle," it is an on-line game in which you have to guess the five-letter word for the day. You get six attempts. To begin the game, you have to pick a five-letter word at random, and from there, if there are letters in that word which are in the "word of the day," they show up in either purple (if the letter is in the word but not that position)

or green (if the letter is in the word in that position). There is some strategy involved, of course, which makes it all the more fun. I love "wordle."

A lot can be said in just five letters. And two five-letter words come to my mind that say more than the universe can contain: Alpha and Omega, the first and the last letters of the Greek alphabet. These letters represent all that can be said; every word (in Greek) is composed of letters between and including Alpha and Omega. All the combinations of words - all that can be spoken or written – lies somewhere between these two letters, Alpha and Omega. They are just five letters long, but these two five-letter words are particularly descriptive, because Jesus is called "the Alpha and Omega." He is the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. He is the firstborn of the Living and the firstborn of the Dead. He was there at Creation and will be there in Consummation. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Words are powerful; words help us understand meaning and message. Words say something that can bring clarification and put an end to confusion. Words communicate ideas that, at times, are beyond words. Such it is with these two five-letter words about Jesus: Alpha and Omega. These are words unique to Jesus, for no other person can ever claim them to be their own as Jesus can. And when, in the book of Revelation, Jesus is described as being "the Alpha and Omega," we get the sense that John was at a loss for words in his attempt to describe all the fullness of who Jesus is.

Alpha. Omega. Try these words in your next "wordle." They might not be the "word of the day," but I can assure you, they are words for all of eternity, words about the One "who was, and is, and is to come."

- Samaritan's Purse Shoe Box ministry can be shopped for all year long. Many of the items on the list are beginning to show up on "clearance" shelves or are back in stock after the Christmas rush. Great time to start buying items for our church to pack.
