From the Pastor...

"Friends inviting friends". That's the answer I give whenever I'm asked what I think is the best church growth plan or program I've ever read about, researched, used, or seen at work. "Friends inviting friends."

I know the heart of the family of faith called Calvary. I know that we all want to reach our community for Christ. We want to impact lives for the sake of Jesus. We want to see people come to Christ and experience His life-transforming power and grace. We want our church's influence, by

the power of the Holy Spirit, to grow in our community. We want to be a beacon of the Gospel of Christ, to be used by God to reach the lost and to grow as a congregation in number as a reflection of the lives God allows us to impact as we make disciples for Jesus. The good news is that God does too. God wants to use us for those things.

But the question is "How do we do that?" That is, how do we reach people? Is there an outreach program that will work for us, that will help bring more people into our church? Is there a plan that we can implement, a book or study that will guide us? Shouldn't we come up with some big plans for events or activities that will draw others to our church?

I'm not saying that here is no room for outreach programs. Sometimes, we need the benefit of some creativity and ingenuity that others have to offer. But, I have come to understand that church outreach is about three things. First, it's about being faithful to Christ in Biblical and Spirit-guided worship and preaching. If these things are not in place, then there's little reason to do outreach. I pray that under my shepherding of this congregation, we have both of these each week, and I ask for your prayers.

Second, it's about the church being willing. And I mean truly willing. I mean willing to do whatever it takes, whatever changes are needed, whatever sacrifices we are called to make, whatever new ministries we need to begin or whatever old ministries we need to end. I mean being willing to put our pride aside, our history aside, our traditions aside, our preferences aside, and instead, be willing to say "Yes" to whatever God leads us to do before we even know what we are saying "Yes" to. Over the past two years, I have come to see that you are that kind of Church. You have said "Yes, Yes, Yes" so many times since I've come to be your pastor, and that spirit of "Yes" is exactly what is needed in order for us to reach our community for Christ.

Third, outreach is about "friends inviting friends." That's the strategy. That's the plan. And I see that going on each week as a new face or two often come to worship with us. That's the best way to do outreach: invite someone. And I don't just mean invite them to church. Invite them to Jesus. Share your faith with them. And in the process, if they are not part of a family of faith like Calvary, invite them to church. Meet them at the door. Drive them if needed. Call, text, or e-mail them a reminder invitation. Follow-up after they come. Friend the world, and invite those friends, old and new, into the fellowship so that they can come to know Christ more fully and experience the joy and strength that comes from being part of Christ's church.

So, it's a pretty simple outreach program that we will be using in the weeks and months and years ahead. It's us being ready, and it's us, you and me, inviting friends.

If we do that, God will do all the rest, and whatever He does will be enough.

2022 Shoebox Project

Thank you to <u>everyone</u> who participated in our <u>Christmas in July Operation Christmas Child</u> project. We received shoeboxes filled with gifts, funds to cover shipping, and items to place in shoeboxes this Fall. As you know, the price on everything has increased significantly over the past few months. Items that previously sold for \$1.00 now cost \$1.25 or more. The cost of shipping boxes has increased from \$9 per box to \$10 per box. Recognizing that many of our members are on limited incomes, the deacons have recommended we lower our goal from 300 boxes to 250 this year. Schools will be starting in a few weeks and merchants are putting their school supplies up for sale

now. Some items may be in short supply this year, so you are encouraged to shop early. The Logan Lawrence Foundation has helped with the cost of shipping and the purchase of shoebox items in the past. However, the investment market is down so we are asking you, if possible, to help with some or all of the shipping cost for your boxes. Thank you!!!
