



From the Pastor...

I recently read an article in a denominational (Baptist) newsletter promoting an online pastor's course the group is offering. The course is designed to address the growing issue that many of the "younger generation" in churches are not giving like most of the "older generation." If you talk to many pastors, they corroborate the story. Churches with lots of young adults and young families know it to be the norm. Many churches are seeing a real need to encourage the "younger generation" to tithe, to give to the work of the church, to participate in offerings as part of their

worship. Denominational leaders across the board work to help pastors seek creative ways to encourage folks in their 20's and 30's and 40's to give to the work of the church. The days of "tithing" as the norm of Christian discipleship are, so it seems, over. And many churches are asking the question: "What do we do?"

I believe the following about giving in general:

- 1) To give, you must believe in the mission. That is, if you are going to give, and I mean really give, you have to believe in the mission of the organization or entity to which you are giving. You have to believe in what they stand for, what they are doing, and why they are doing it. You have to be bought in.
- 2) To give, you must believe it is important. That is, if you are going to give, you must believe that what is being done with the financial resources you are providing fills a need that is of extreme value. You must believe that your gifts actually make a difference. You have to see that it's not just another possible use of your resources; it's an essential use of your resources.
- 3) To give, you must believe it will be used wisely. That is, you must have a significant level of trust in those who make decisions about the resources you are providing. You have to believe that they are transparent, honest, wise, stewardly, serious. You have to be able to look at the numbers yourself and know that it all adds up, that it makes sense, and that it makes good use of those resources.
- 4) To give, you must believe it is rewarding. That is, you have to experience something yourself in the act of giving. It must move you. You must personally sense that in giving, you are blessed, that you are better, that you are being molded for your own personal good by the act of giving. Yes, giving may "hurt" the pocketbook at times, but that hurt is alleviated by the way your heart and soul are shaped in the process.

As October rolls around and we near the end of the fiscal year in our church's life, it is a good time for us to evaluate our giving individually. Of course, the church budget numbers tell part of the story: How are we doing as a whole in our giving relative to the budget? That's a good question. But, a set of better questions are these: Do I personally believe in the mission of Calvary? Do I personally believe what we are doing here is important? Can I trust those who steward the church's resources, having no identifiable reason to distrust that what I give is being used wisely? Do I believe that in my giving, I will be rewarded by becoming a more faithful disciple of Jesus, the One who gave Himself for me, for us?

So, Calvary family, personally ask yourself these questions. And if the answer to all of them is "Yes," then I'm sure you know what to do next.

This year, our Shoebox Packing Party will be **Saturday, November 5, 2022** from 10am until 2pm in The Learning Center. Pizza lunch will be served from 11:30-12:30pm. There will be two work shifts: 10am-12pm and 12-2pm. Volunteers can sign up for either or both time periods. Sign up sheets will be in The Hub. Our goal is to pack 250 boxes with gifts for children of the world. Shoebox items are needed for the boxes and can include: flashlights & batteries, hand towels or washcloths, bar soap, T-shirts (plain with no words or logos), crayons, school supplies, toothbrushes, toy cars or trucks, combs, scissors, pencils and notebooks, hats, plastic toys and figures, coloring books, sunglasses, hair ties, colored pencils, pens and pencil sharpeners, puzzles, balls, socks, rulers, notebook paper, journals or notebooks. Items we cannot send include: toothpaste, candy, liquids, war toys, glass items. Shoebox items should be brought to the church by **October 30th**. Volunteers to set up for this event are needed on November 3rd at 6:30pm. If you cannot attend the packing party, you may take shoeboxes home to fill with items and return them to the church by November 6th.
