From the Pastor...

Thanksgiving and weddings have some things in common. Both can take quite a bit of preparation. For a wedding, the list is almost endless: from securing the venue to finding the caterer to renting the tuxedos to sending out the invitations. It can take months. For thanksgiving, there is making the list of what will be served, then a grocery list, then the

grocery shopping, then cleaning the house, then doing all that cooking. It can take days. Both of these, Thanksgiving and weddings, are an opportunity for time with loved ones, celebration, and sharing around the table. And both take lots of time to prepare for. And in both cases, all that work culminates in a brief experience of a few minutes or a few hours at best. The meal that took days to prepare is consumed almost instantly, and it's all over. The wedding plans that took months come to life and are over before you can scarf down that last piece of wedding cake. Lots of work, lots of planning, lots of energy... and "poof", it's over.

All the "work" of the Christian life is in preparation for the coming of our Lord or our going to be with the Lord. But the Christian life is unlike thanksgiving and a wedding in one important sense: the end goal isn't a "poof" on the calendar of life. The end goal is eternal. It endures into all of time. Being with the Lord into all of eternity (we call it "Heaven") doesn't come and go like the temporal and transient experiences of this life. We aren't working, laboring, investing in something that will be so quickly consumed, over in an instant. And if that is so, then that should make all of our preparations even more worth while, and it should encourage us to "keep on keepin' on."

So, this thanksgiving, give thanks for that wedding we are all anticipating, when the Lord comes to take His bride, the Church. And give thanks that when He does, the wedding celebration will never, ever end.
