From the Pastor...

I'm not big on "New Year's Resolutions," but sometimes, it's helpful to have some goals in mind, and what better time to articulate those goals than the start of a new year. So, as we as a church family enter into the year 2024, I'd like to lay out a few resolutions for Calvary in the coming year:

January 2024
