



From the Pastor...

I love the book of Ecclesiastes. That may sound strange, given that the book is potentially depressing! "Meaningless" says the teacher. "Everything is meaningless." The teacher lays out how it is that in his life, he has searched for understanding of the meaning of life, and he has found that it all seems meaningless. Seeking wisdom is futile. Seeking pleasure is futile. Work and toil also are meaningless. "A chasing after the wind." Even those who acquire wealth,

possessions, and honor, so that they lack nothing, "God does not enable them to enjoy these things, but a stranger enjoys them. This is vanity; it is a grievous ill." (6:2) The righteous perish in their righteousness, and the wicked prolong their life in their wickedness. Whether you are swift, strong, wise, intelligent, skillful: "time and chance happen to them all. For no one can anticipate the time of disaster. Like fish taken in a cruel net, and like birds caught in a snare, so mortals are snared at a time of calamity, when it suddenly falls upon them." (9:12)

Depressing, isn't it? And that's why I like this little strange book. It's real life.

In this little book is a profound question, a life-long search of sorts, a search for the meaning of life itself. And lest we think the answer to the meaning of life is made entirely clear to us who have faith in Jesus and who trust God completely and who have faith that "can move mountains," this little book says to us "Not so fast!" This little book lets the most faithful among us ask some hard questions about life... even the meaning of life itself, and come to the determination that the meaning of life is not quite so intuitively obvious as our religious inclinations might point us. Life is hard; life is messy; life is complex; life is mysterious. And there are, for all of us, no matter the measure of our faith and trust in God, those times when we, like the wise Teacher of old, sit down with our head in our hands and ponder the meaning of it all.

And that is part of the journey of faith in God. The abundant life that Jesus offers and promised does not completely annihilate our times of despair in life, our times of uncertainty in the unknown, our times of wrestling with the very essential nature of life itself. Rather, the abundant life that Jesus offers and promised allows us to journey through life, not with all our questions answered in totality, but with the surety that we have one who holds our hands through the mysterious maze, one step at a time, knowing that he has said to us "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

So, just so you know, if you ever have that moment when you wonder deep down in the core of your being "What is the meaning of all of this after all?", Ecclesiastes is a reminder to know that you are not alone *in* the question, and Jesus says that you are not alone *with* the question. And maybe *that* is the meaning of life anyway... "No, never alone; no, never alone."




