



From the Pastor...

You may have heard that at the June 2024 annual convention of the SBC, the largest Protestant denomination in America, the issue of the role of women in the church was front and center. About 62 percent (just shy of the 66 percent required to amend the constitution) of the delegates of the convention voted in favor of the amendment, which, had it passed, would have added a qualification to the SBC Constitution that churches in friendly cooperation affirm, appoint or employ "only men as any kind of pastor or elder as

qualified by Scripture." Notice, it says "any kind."

There is much that ought to be said in regard to this move. While Calvary Church is not affiliated with any particular denomination, what happens within the larger context of conservative Christian witness is still important to us as we seek to understand the biblical and theological principles which guide our own unique expression of our Christian faith as Calvary Church.

In regards to the issue of the role of women in the church, while there is little room here for the level of conversation that is needed, I'll point out a few guiding biblical and theological principles that are foundational to Calvary Church's full affirmation of devoted Christian women and men whom God calls to any and all roles in the church.

- 1. There is ample evidence in both the Old and New Testaments that, while the culture of the Bible was almost exclusively patriarchal, the Bible names many women who exercised roles that went beyond the norm. Deborah, Hannah, and Huldah are OT examples. Junia, Phoebe, Chloe, Priscilla, Lydia, Euodia, and Syntyche: these women in the NT all in some way assumed roles that challenge the idea that women are unequivocally excluded from Gospel ministry in the church.
- 2. In the New Testament, we are told that with the coming of the Gospel of Jesus, God poured out his Spirit on "both men and women" and that "both men and women will prophesy." (Acts 2) To "prophesy" was to proclaim God's message, which is essentially what it means to "preach."
- 3. In the Gospels, Jesus seems to break down long-standing barriers when it comes to his interaction with women, which could be viewed as a precedent not only for their equality when it comes to access to the Gospel message but also to equality with men in every regard when it comes to matters of faith. And Paul would write in Galatians 3 that "there is neither male nor female" when it comes to the Gospel. All of this is reinforced when the women leave the empty tomb to become the first evangelists, the first to share the Good News of His resurrection.
- 4. While there are a select number of scripture passages in Paul's letters that would seem to prohibit women from filling certain roles in the church (I Timothy 2 and 3), there is also the problem of how we should treat the passage Paul writes in I Corinthians 14 in which he says that women should be silent in "all the churches" and if they have a question, they should not speak in church, but should wait to talk to their husbands at home. If a person is going to be consistent in applying the plain meaning of Paul's instructions to all churches throughout all of time, then the only logical and consistent next step for those who interpret scripture to mandate exclusion of women from being deacons or pastors is to take Paul at his word and furthermore mandate that women be silent in church. Affirming women in ministry is not about "feminism." The issue should not be manipulated by those with a humanly-defined feminist political or social agenda that throws the door open wide to a more broad progressive agenda, and shame on those who would do so. This is about the Gospel, and about who God may choose to call in whatever capacity God chooses to call to serve His Bride, the Church. This is about who we think God is, and how we think God acts... and also about who we think we are. This is about the church's witness to the world of a God who either does or doesn't call women and men of His own will and choosing. This is about how we understand who God in Christ is. And when all the biblical and theological argumentation has been worked through and through, it seems to me that we don't need to be worried too much about women who earnestly and authentically desire to serve Christ in His church in whatever role He chooses to call them to. I think the thing to be more concerned about is the Church's witness to the world. God help us.
