But one of the servants was cautious, and fearful, so he dug a hole and hid what he had been given in the ground. And the way the

parable unfolds, this cautious, fearful servant was rebuked by his master. (Matthew 25)



We have a fantastic facility on this campus, and you have wisely made the choice to share the buildings on our campus with others: two other churches, a Christian school, and various community groups such as AA and NA. From time to time, we receive large financial gifts from faithful church members who leave Calvary as a beneficiary of part of their estate upon their homegoing to be with the Lord. We have a large endowment that was established years ago by the Logans and Lawrences, pillars in this church, that provides funds for missions, benevolence, and education ministries. We have a solid financial footing based on the faithfulness of our congregation in meeting the ministry needs of the church.

My counsel to us is to not be unduly cautious or fearful with these things over which we are stewards. The Lord has entrusted to us these resources not so that we will "dig a hole in the ground and hide it" out of caution or fear, but rather, so that we can be faithful in using all the enormity of our resources so that they will produce a harvest. Maybe the Lord is going to be asking us now and in the days ahead to use what we have been given, individually and as a church, in ways that will produce even more than we can imagine for His Kingdom's sake. So, let's be sure to faithfully use what we have been given rather than store it away. And we can do so, knowing that the Lord will surely continue to be faithful to us, just as He has always been.


Ladies' Prayer Breakfast
