



From the Pastor...

My grandmother Blankenship (my mom's mom) was a dear soul. She was a woman of enormous faith, full of spunk and humor and an endearing silliness. It's possibly odd that of all that I remember about her, one thing I think of so very often is how, as the days of December turned the corner to become days in January, she would

comment how she longed for the days to be getting longer. December 21 was a day of celebration for her, I believe, because she knew that with each passing morning and evening, the next day would be a little bit longer, with a little more sunlight, and a little less darkness.

No doubt, many of us long for more sunlight and less darkness in our days. There are those days that are filled with the dark shadows of loneliness, sickness, pain, brokenness. There are days that seem like the night is so long, as we wait for the sun to come up the next morning: a morning that brings the hope of healing, wholeness, restoration, renewal. I know that for some in our church family, there have been extended seasons of wintry darkness. There have been hard times. All of us, in our own ways, have those long, dark periods. They are not dark in the sense of a foreboding evil; but dark in the sense that we long for the promise of the light... and with the light, a sense of joyful renewal, of possibility, of the hope for brighter days. But for some in our church family, the days have been particularly difficult.

My prayer for you is that you rest in the assurance that "weeping may last for the night, but joy comes in the morning." My prayer is that you will see brighter days ahead, with more sunlight than darkness, more joy than sorry, more health than sickness, more faith than fear, more trust than worry, more Jesus than anything else. Know that we are with you and we love you. And more than that, God is with you and God loves you. And His mercies are new every morning, even on a cold January morning. Just remember... the days are getting longer... and there's a little more sunshine every day... and with the sunshine comes the goodness of God.



During this series, we will take an in-depth journey through the book of Ephesians to discover the amazing destiny that God has for all who are in Christ.


