

## From the Pastor...

"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe." (John 20:29) Jesus spoke these words just a week after His resurrection to a disciple named Thomas, the one who was missing from the room where the disciples were gathered a week before when Jesus appeared to them after His resurrection. It was "the first day of the week," or Sunday, when the Lord was raised. And for a whole week, Thomas dealt with the

uncertainty of knowing if what the other disciples had told him was true. A whole week. But now, it's the next Sunday, and the disciples are gathered together again, and Thomas is with them this time. And Jesus appears again.

A whole week. Think about all that must have gone through Thomas' mind during that week. Think of how the disciples who had seen the Lord must have tried their best to convince him that what they were saying was true. Think about the mental and emotional struggle Thomas went through, not sure what to believe, even unsure if he could trust the testimony of his closest friends who had traveled with Jesus like a band of brothers. Think of his grief over the death of Jesus, now compounded by the anxiety of uncertainty. A whole week to grapple with what to believe.

In some ways, some of us, if not all of us, grapple with what to believe for weeks, maybe months, maybe years. For some, faith is easy. For others, faith is hard. It's hard to know what to believe. And for some -- maybe members of your family or people you work with or those you meet in your day-to-day or even you yourself -- for some, faith in that which we cannot see is almost a bridge too far.

And Jesus knows that. Jesus knows it will take us stretching our faith to believe what we have not seen. He tells Thomas as much: "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe." The word "yet" is the operative word. I have not seen, and yet I believe. You have not seen, and yet you believe. And it's been much longer than a week. It's now been almost 2000 years.

But we know that one day, our faith will end in sight. The words of the hymn "It is Well" echo the reality of faith without seeing: "And Lord haste the day when my faith shall be sight." One day, every eye will see Him, yours and mine included. And in the meantime, we believe what we cannot see.

Oh, yes, it's been a long week. But, church, Sunday's coming. And you can believe it.

#### **Monthly Hands - On Missions Opportunity**


In April, we are collecting the following items for the Western Carolina Rescue Ministries. Please bring these items to the collection box in The Hub by end of April.
