A Gospel to Share

It's been called "The Great Commission." At the end of the Gospel of Matthew, as the eleven disciples of Jesus went to Galilee, there they met the Resurrected Jesus. Matthew says "When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted." Then, Jesus tells them that all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to him, and he tells them to, therefore, go and

make disciples of all nations, baptize them, and teach them in the ways of Jesus.

"Make disciples of ALL nations," Jesus says. Not just a select few, but ALL nations.

I've never felt personally called to what used to be termed "the foreign mission field." I know missionaries, and you do to, who have picked up and moved to another nation to do mission work and to share the gospel in tangible ways. Many make their home in foreign lands for the sake of fulfilling this commission the Lord gave to his disciples.

Taking the Gospel of Jesus to the nations is part of the mandate to the Church, and it requires us to have a "Kingdom of God" mindset, knowing that national boundaries that draw lines between peoples of the earth are not to be inhibitors to the spread of the Gospel. But maybe we miss this point: those same lines between peoples of the earth should also not be boundaries that followers of Jesus use to our economic or nationalistic advantage. If we, the church, really are Kingdom people, then our desire should be for ALL to not only hear and receive the gospel of Jesus, but for ALL to be treated as deserving the same rights and blessings that we receive. We should, as Kingdom people, never desire our own prosperity and greatness at the expense of other nations or lands.

The Gospel of Jesus is the great leveler. It puts all people on the same field, at the same level. As "sharers" of the Gospel and "practicers" of the Gospel, none of us should feel more nationally superior to "them," whoever "them" is. If the Kingdom of God is global in effect, we, as Kingdom people, must be global in our perspective. Nationalistic fervor must be held in check by a global Kingdom perspective, understanding what Paul meant when in Ephesians 2, the scriptures teach that "in (Christ's) flesh he has made both groups into one and has broken down the dividing wall... that he might create in himself one new humanity in place of two, thus making peace."

For followers of Jesus, no matter one's country of origin, nationalism and patriotism must be held in check by the Gospel of Jesus and by the Church's understanding that to share Christ with the nations is also to dismantle in us all nationalistic arrogance, abuse, injustice, and greed. To share Christ with the nations also means that we share ourselves with the nations. Yes, it means we have to give up some things. But what we can get in this world in return is far more valuable: peace.



June 21, 10am-2pm


