

From the Pastor...

During the Christmas season, Christians are reminded through songs and scriptures of many titles for Jesus – some given to him at his birth, others used to refer to him in the New Testament. Immanual, meaning "God with us." Messiah, meaning "God's anointed." He is called "the Prince of Peace" based on Isaiah 9:6. He is called "the Light of the World" in John 8:12. He is "the Lamb of God", "the Alpha and the Omega", "the Bread of Life." The New Testament is full of descriptive names for the Lord, the Savior, the Son of God.

Several hundred years after the start of the Christian church, Christians who reflected on the meaning of Jesus the Christ and His nature came to refer to Jesus with yet another phrase, a description: "Very God of very God." This phrase – this description of Jesus' essence – was adopted by the Church at the Council of Nicaea in 325 AD. It was adopted to refute the teachings of a presbyter (church elder) named Arius who claimed Jesus was the first being created by God. Arius claimed that Jesus was a created being, not eternal God. Arius taught that Jesus was created out of nothing by the Father and existed before the rest of creation, but he was not eternal in the same way the Father was. It caused quite a stir, and much debate. But the Church quickly deemed such teachings "heresy." The rest of the Nicene Creed, as it was later called, spells it out with resounding clarity:

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true (very) God from true (very) God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through Him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation He came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

This creed affirms what the Gospel writer named John means when he writes: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.... And the Word became flesh." Jesus was born of the Virgin Mary, but Jesus was not created in the womb as you and I are. Jesus was always, because Jesus is God... "very God of very God."

So, when we come to Christmas, let's always remember who Jesus is: God wrapped in flesh, then wrapped in swaddling clothes, then wrapped in a dusty Judean tunic, then wrapped in burial clothes, and now wrapped in the white arraignment of glory. And, when we come to Christmas, let's always remember that when we worship Jesus, pray to Jesus, talk to Jesus, listen to Jesus, sit with Jesus... we are with the God who created it all, our human flesh included... you and me included. Jesus is "very God of very God." And that is very Good!

(Note that the Christmas Angel program does not provide clothing, shoes, or bedding, as these essentials are available year-round at the Crisis Ministries.)




At-Home Christmas Bags
